The Niko Fiti Campaign is a flagship CSR initiative of the Kenya Reinsurance Corporation Limited (Kenya Re). It has touched and changed the lives of over 7,000 persons with physical disability over the last six years.

The initiative involves the distribution of assistive and mobility devices as well as mobile vending units in Kenya. It also empowers persons with disability to undertake their daily activities with minimal dependency.

In 2017 alone, Niko Fiti benefitted over 1,300 through provision of wheelchairs, special seats, try-cycles, crutches, polio boots, urine bags, prosthesis, KFO splints, AFO splints, yaya seats,

walking canes and spinal braces in Nyamira, Homa Bay, Kitale, Bungoma, Kerugoya, Embu and Meru counties.

In September 2017, Kenya Re kicked off its flagship CSR programme project dubbed, "Niko Fiti PWDs Education Integration Programme". This has facilitated modification of facilities in selected schools to ensure access, mobility and integration of students with disability.

The project started with the facelift of two national secondary schools, namely Lenana School and Moi Girls School, Isinya. Both schools had their student's cubicles, sanatorium and washroom facilities refurbished. The project also involved construction of ramps to

ease mobility for the students with disability.

Additionally, a percentage of the CSR funds went to the refurbishment of Shining Star Children's Centre, which is a home that provides care to children with disability in the slum of Mukuru kwa Njenga, Nairobi. During the first visit to the home, Kenya Re discovered that it lacked a proper sanitary kitchen, good beds, toys for the children and so much more. The Corporation decided to help out by providing a proper sanitary kitchen away from the sleeping area, new beds and mattresses as well as children play mats.

This year, Kenya Re is partnering with the Kenya Institute of Special Education (KISE) for the Niko

Fiti legacy project. This project has seen Kenya Re adopt a block in their new state of the art Psycho Education Assessment and Rehabilitation Centre that will cater for persons with physical disabilities.

The block hosts a hydrotherapy pool, a rehabilitation gymnasium and treatment rooms complete with observation/learning rooms. The Corporation's participation in the project will have a far-reaching

positive impact not only in the country but the whole of Africa as the assessment centre that will serve people from beyond Kenya.

The project makes a significant contribution towards attainment of the Big Four Agenda under the pillar of Universal Health Coverage. The fact that the block will be in existence for many years makes it the legacy project of the Corporation.
