We kindly seek clarification regarding the requirement for the ICTA Level 1 Accreditation Certificate for Systems Applications. Given that this tender relates to the supply and delivery of End User Computing Devices (Laptops), we would appreciate confirmation on whether the Systems Applications accreditation is mandatory for this procurement. Specifically, kindly clarify whether a bidder possessing only the ICTA Level 1 Accreditation Certificate for End User Computing Devices, without the Systems Applications accreditation, would be deemed non-responsive or subject to disqualification.	The requirement of ICTA Level 1 Accreditation Certificate for Systems Applications is not required here. The accreditation that is required is ICTA Level 1 Accreditation Certificate for End User Computing Devices – where laptops fall under.
The specifications reference both Intel® UHD Graphics 620 and Intel® Iris® Xe Graphics, while the specified Intel® Core™ Ultra 5 125U processor is not available with either option and instead comes with the newer Intel® Graphics architecture. Kindly confirm the intended graphics requirement to enable accurate compliance and pricing.	Let bidders propose a newer or latest processor with the latest graphics chip available.
